

Forest Farm

The tropical forest at EARTH is extensive and offers the university, its students and visitors the opportunity to learn about sustainable management of the forest.

EARTH maintains its extensive tropical forest to protect our natural resources and prevent global warming through a Carbon Fixing program. The success of this program has allowed EARTH to declare itself as a CO2 neutral environment.

This philosophy of forest management also includes a program of wood extraction combined with continuous planting and renovation of these plantations.

The forest plantations of native and non-native species covers an area of 700 hectares plus 1000 hectares of natural forest including primary and secondary vegetation, wetlands and other forest areas located on the riverbanks.

The forest program at EARTH offers visitors the opportunity to become involved in:

- Extraction and commercialization of bamboo
- Management of forest plantations
- Management of greenhouses
- Carbon Fixation
- Eco-tourism
